This Amendment No. 2 ("Amendment No. 2") amends and supplements the Tender Offer Statement on Schedule TO, originally filed with the Securities and Exchange Commission (the "SEC") on October 3, 2017, by Hines Global REIT II, Inc., a Maryland Corporation (the "Company"), as amended by Amendment No. 1 filed with the SEC on October 20, 2017 (as amended, and as may be further supplemented or amended from time to time, the "Schedule TO"), to purchase for cash up to approximately \$200 million in shares of the Company's common stock, in any combination of Class A shares, Class T shares or Class I shares, par value \$0.001 per share (the "Shares"). The Company is offering to purchase the Shares at a price of \$9.69 per share and the maximum number of Shares that will be accepted by the Company's offer (unless the offer is amended in accordance with applicable law) is 20,639,835 Shares. The Company's offer is being made upon the terms and subject to the conditions set forth in the Offer to Purchase, dated October 3, 2017, and in the related Letter of Transmittal.

The information contained in the Offer to Purchase and the related Letter of Transmittal, previously filed with the Schedule TO are incorporated into this Amendment No. 2 by reference in response to all the items of the Schedule TO, except that such information is hereby amended and supplemented to the extent specifically provided herein. You should read this Amendment No. 2 together with the Schedule TO, and the related Offer to Purchase and Letter of Transmittal.

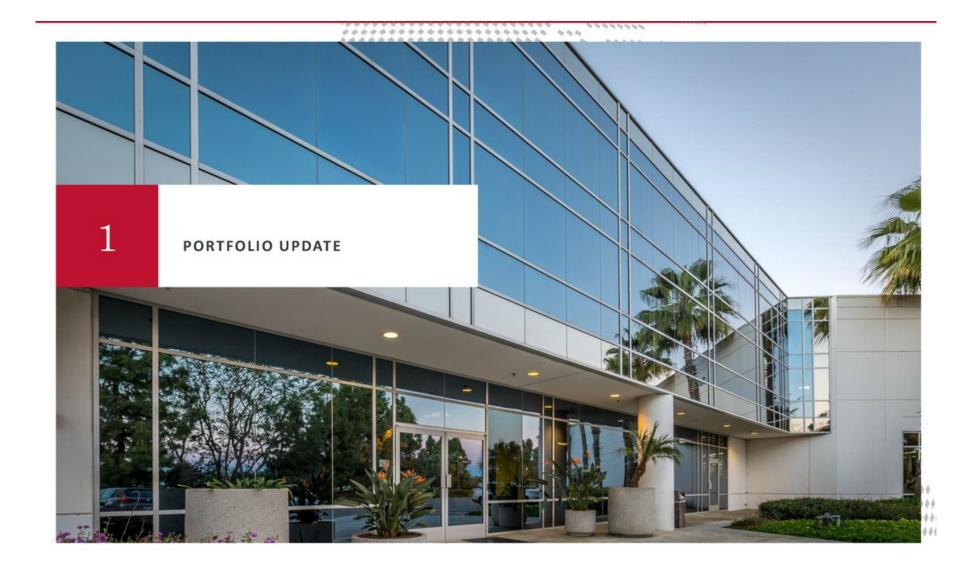

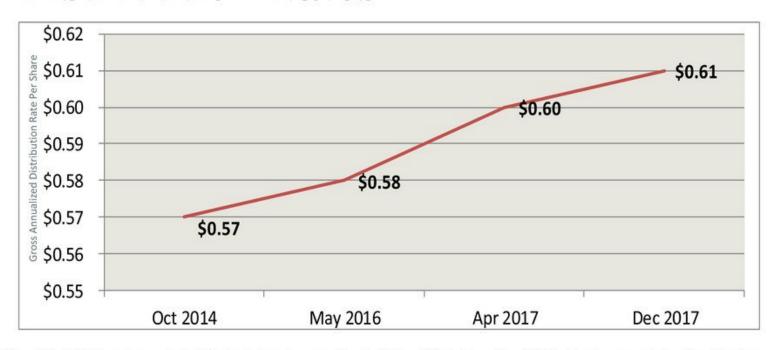

Distribution Rates^{1,2}



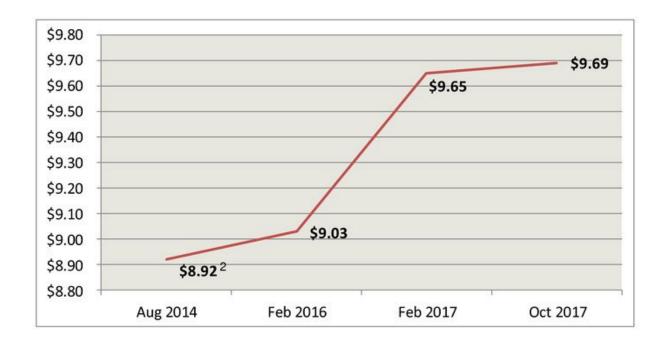
¹Hines Global REIT II has not generated sufficient cash flows from operations to fully fund distributions paid and distributions have exceeded earnings. Therefore, some or all of Hines Global REIT II's distributions have been and may continue to be paid from other sources, such as proceeds from its debt financings, proceeds from this offering, cash advances by Hines Global REIT II Advisors LP (the "Advisor"), cash resulting from a waiver or deferral of fees and/or proceeds from the sale of assets. For the six months ended June 30, 2017 and the years ended December 31, 2016 and 2015, respectively, Hines Global REIT II funded 45%, 60% and 23% of total distributions with cash flows from financing activities, which includes offering proceeds. Hines Global REIT II has not placed a cap on the amount of distributions that may be paid from any of these sources. The use of sources other than cash flow from operations to fund distributions could lower returns. The availability and timing of distributions Hines Global REIT II may pay is uncertain and cannot be assured. The Hines Global REIT II board of directors may also amend or terminate the distribution reinvestment plan for any reason upon 10 days' prior notice.

²The gross annualized distribution rate assumes that the distribution rate initially declared as of each date presented was paid for a full year. Distributions for Class T Shares are calculated based on the gross annualized distribution rate less the distribution and stockholder servicing fees of 1.0% per annum of the gross offering price per share or the NAV per share, now that Hines Global REIT II is no longer offering primary shares, that are payable with respect to such Class T Shares. Distributions for Class I Shares are calculated based on the gross annualized distribution rate less the distribution and stockholder servicing fees of 0.25% per annum of the gross offering price per share or the NAV per share, now that Hines Global REIT II is no longer offering primary shares, that are payable with respect to such Class I Shares. The actual distribution rate for Class T Shares and Class I Shares will vary based on the total amount of distribution and stockholder servicing fees payable.

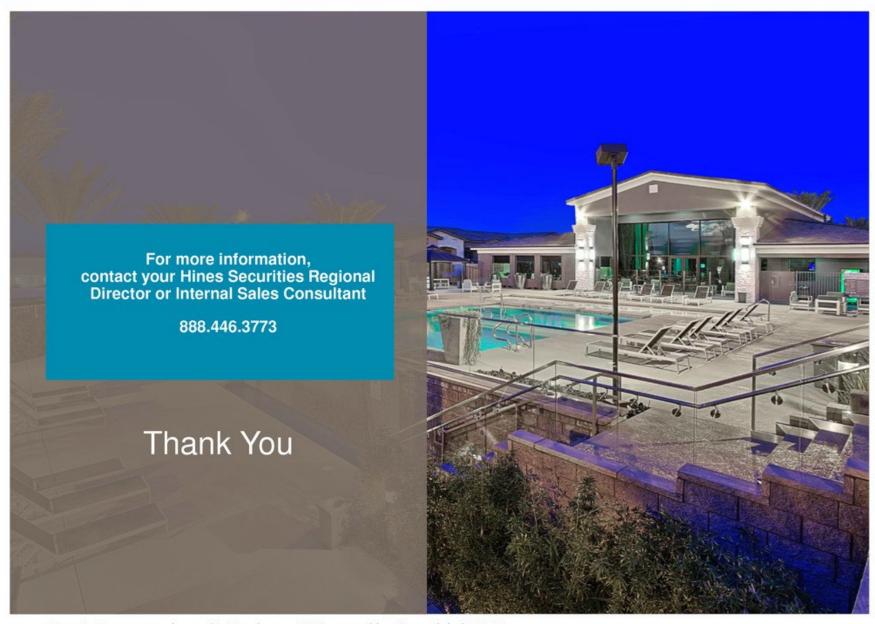
